

## Summer School Important Information

## **Construction Modifications**

Due to ongoing construction at both the Upper & Freshman Campuses there will be logistical modifications that need to be made throughout the summer. Summer school is entirely at the Upper Campus (West) and portions of the parking lot are being repaved, which will limit parking lot usage at different times throughout the months of June & July.

## Student Parking: New Student South Lot

During the summer, all student drivers will enter through the South Entrance and park in the new Student South Lot that is next to the tennis courts. Students will only park in that lot. The other lots will be worked on at different times throughout the summer. Please arrive early and take into account the time it will take to walk from the parking lot to the summer school classrooms that are closer to the north end. Per summer rules, students cannot have more than 3 tardies per session.

## Student Drop-off: North Lot

Students will be dropped off in the North Parking Lot. As you enter the North Lot entrance, follow the signs to the left, and drive towards the front of the building. Please pull up as far as you can towards the softball field. Pulling up as far as possible will make the traffic system more efficient. Students will enter the building through the new North Main Entrance. After drop-off, parents will follow the signs and exit through the drive that leads past the BOE building.

# Student Pick-up: North Lot

Parents will pull into a parking spot when arriving to pick-up their student. When exiting, parents will go out the same direction as pick-up.

There will be a police officer directing trafficking by the North Entrance to make the drop-off & pick-up process as efficient as possible. That being said, please understand that there are a high number of students taking summer school and the process will take some time. We appreciate your flexibility and understanding.

## <u>Bussing</u>

For students who are taking the bus, session 2 bus routes will be available on June 29th at this <u>website</u>. Students who are taking the bus for session 1 & 2, might have a different route for session 2 than session 1 -- so please check the website. Please use your student's ID number for the username and password. For incoming freshmen, the ID number is underneath the student's name on the chromebook pick-up informational sheet.



#### **COVID Protocols**

Based on ISBE guidelines, students are still required to wear masks and self-certify each day. Students will drop off the self-certification forms as they enter the building. Students can use the same form as the regular school year. For students who do not have the form, please print out the <u>COVID certification</u> form for day 1 of summer school. Students will receive a booklet of forms on day 1 for further use.

Parents/Students will receive an email by July 6th for session 2, from your student's teacher. The email will include room numbers, plus more information — so please be on the lookout for that email. Staff & Senior student leaders will be available on day 1 to assist students to their classrooms.
