Observation Protocol:

	Focus	Guiding Questions
First Watch	Watch the video in its entirety to get an overall impression of the lesson	• What do you notice overall? • Is the lesson going the way you thought it would go?
Second Watch	Watch the Students	• How well are students complying with your expectations? • Approximately how many are? • Approximately how many are not?
Third Watch	Watch the Teacher	• What is the teacher saying in his/her directions (you may choose to script the dialogue)? • What is the teacher doing as he/she is giving directions? • What decisions did the teacher make during the lesson in response to students' degree of compliance?

	What makes it better than a 1? What did you see that you wanted to see in yourself and your students?

	Based on your response to the above question, what goal might you set around getting this task/lesson to a 10?	
LEARN	What strategies could your mentor provide to help you accomplish this goal?	
	How do you want your mentor to share these strategies with you? • Model (with students/without students) • Video • Co Teaching	
	What additional questions do you have for your mentor in helping you reach your goal?	

IMPROVE	What new learning have you constructed through this process that you will carry forward/apply to your practice?	
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
