Delicate aromatics including hints of rose and pineapple round out the supple tannin structure of this wine. The light red color from the pale grape skin provides an ethereal backdrop to the balanced acidity of this unique noble grape transplanted from Italy to a remote region of California. Crafted from grapes that ripened late in the coastal-influenced continental climate of the valley, this wine beautifully expresses the uniqueness of Humboldt County climate and soil.




