

Rainbow Prom Terms & Conditions & Code of Conduct

By purchasing a ticket to Rainbow Prom, you agree to the following:

1. Eligibility

- Attendees must be 14–20 years old (no exceptions).
- Valid school ID or government-issued ID may be required for entry.

2. Ticket Policy

- Tickets are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Lost tickets cannot be replaced.

3. Code of Conduct

All attendees must:

- Treat others with respect—no harassment, bullying, hate speech, or discrimination of any kind (including based on race, gender, sexuality, disability, or religion).
- Follow all instructions from chaperones, staff, or venue personnel.
- No drugs, alcohol, vaping, or smoking (including outside the venue).
- No weapons or violent behavior.
- No inappropriate attire (e.g., hate symbols, excessively revealing clothing per venue rules).
- Respect the venue property—damages will result in liability.

Guests aged 18–20: You are solely responsible for your actions and well-being.

4. Safety & Liability

- Release of Liability: You (and your guardians, if applicable) release Yakima Pride, its volunteers, and the venue from any claims or damages arising from your participation.
- Assumption of Risk: You understand that events carry inherent risks (e.g., dancing, crowds) and participate voluntarily.
- Medical Emergency: On-site personnel may secure medical treatment for you; you may be responsible for associated costs.

5. Enforcement

- Violations may result in immediate removal without refund.
- Yakima Pride reserves the right to refuse entry or eject attendees for safety or behavioral concerns.
