- 1. You're the driver of your own bus--fuel and steer it how you want
- 2. Vision, desire, and focus drive the bus in the right direction. Focus on what you want, not what you don't want
 - a. We are winners, not whiners...what do winners do? Solve problems, create, strive
- 3. Fuel your ride with positive energy--feed the positive dog
 - a. One great golf shot theory: play a terrible round of golf but you always remember the one GREAT shot you had on the course that day
 - Use this to wrap up your class/day: share a success you had today or what you were proud of
- 4. Invite people on your bus and share vision for the road ahead
- 5. Don't waste your energy on those who don't get on your bus (don't want to go where you want to drive)...don't take it personally
- 6. Post a sign..."No energy vampires". Your vision and positivity must be greater than everyone's negativity and doubt. Positive energy is like a muscle--must work it out to get stronger
- 7. Enthusiasm attracts more passengers and energizes them during the ride. It is contagious (energy is)
- 8. Love your passengers. Help bring out the best in others, serve them, recognize them, listen to them, make time for them.
