De-Annexation -2025-01 for property located at 0 Hove Rd

Application submitted by Justin Burdick. The property owner is Howard Nau. The purpose of the application requesting De-Annexation is that there is no clear background as to why this small parcel was created and annexed into the City of Melba as it is not of a viable size. The request is to De-Annex the parcel and revert it back to Canyon County.

The Parcel is described as PIN 281530-10 0 Hove Rd., Melba, Canyon County Idaho, and is more particularly described as:

Including that portion of the Southwest Half of the abandoned Union Pacific Railroad, known as the Murphy Branch of the Oregon-Shortline Railroad, described as follows:

COMMENCING at a found 5/8-inch iron pin and cap marked J-U-B 972 monument the West Quarter comer of said Section I; thence

South 89° 27' 26" East a distance of 1,296.14 feet along the Southerly boundary line of the Northwest Quarter of said Section I to the Southwest comer of the said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section I to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;

thence leaving said Southerly boundary North 00° 17' 11" West a distance of 1,321.10 feet along the Westerly boundary line of the said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section I to the Northwest comer of said Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section I; thence leaving said Westerly boundary line
