1. Community Connections

- a. <u>Debate Outreach Discord</u>: offers free debate resources, programs, tournaments, and opportunities for aspiring debaters.
- b. **PF Discord**: Community wide Discord server.
- c. <u>Debate Reddit</u>: Community wide Reddit server.
- d. <u>PF Debate Reddit</u>: Community wide Reddit server.

2. Prep Stealing (this is a good thing!)

- a. <u>Case List Wiki</u> is an open list of real, verified, and disclosed cases from debaters across the country.
- b. <u>Logos debate</u> has a ton of useful cards which can help build up your block/back files.
- c. Circuit Debater is a website where debaters (PF & LD) will post past cases and sometimes blocks as examples for the community to offer guidance. Debaters can use this resource to see what high quality cases look like.
- d. debatev.com is an online evidence database designed for PF and Policy debaters.
