

4th Grade Rock Eagle Overnight Trip:

February 25-26, 2025

The Rock Eagle 4-H Center is an extension of the University of GA and runs as an Environmental Education Program located in Eatonton, GA.

What will my child learn?

Students will participate in 3 day classes and one evening class. Classes are led by Rock Eagle Instructors. Jackson Chaperones & Teachers attend classes with their students. Sample classes are—

- Lake Ecology - Watershed Studies - Orienteering



What are the cabins like?

Each cabin has several bunk rooms, a chaperone room and a sitting room. There are shower and bathroom facilities in each cabin. The cabins are equipped with air conditioning and heating units. Students will be with classmates of their gender.

What is the dining hall like?

The dining hall serves food cafeteria style. Students will enter through a turnstile and be served their entrée and sides by our dining hall staff. Some side items may be self-serve. Students will have a variety of drink options, including water, sweet/unsweet tea, milk, and juice. The students sit together as a school group at tables.

How does the dining hall accommodate dietary restrictions?

Rock Eagle is a peanut-free facility. Tree nuts are not used in the school menus. By completing your child's registration and medical form, we will be able to alert the dining hall of any dietary restrictions before the trip so that accommodations can be made if needed.

How will my child receive medication?

Nurse Kellie will be in charge of medicine distribution. You will need to fill out a Medical Release form. Specifics on preparing the medication will be provided by February 15th. Form here: <https://tinyaps.com/?medicineform>

What should we pack for this trip?

A basic equipment/packing list will be provided before the trip. Please make sure to send OLD clothes & OLD sturdy shoes (tennis shoes, hiking boots, etc.) A raincoat is a must! Classes go outside, rain or shine so it is important to prepare accordingly.
