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I am an award-winning director and writer of hybrid work based in NYC.

I am currently developing opera-theatre works with Stefania de Kenessey/Annie Finch, Paul Pinto and Kamala Sankaram.

I have constructed 39 works for the stage (16 original hybrid works, 10 opera-theatre and music-theatre works, 8 adaptations of novels & short stories and 5 classic plays). I work in a collaborative, process-driven way to fuse different disciplines into a cohesive whole.

I co-founded the tiny mythic theatre company (1988-1995).

I am the Founding Artistic Director Emeritus of HERE, an award-winning progressive arts center in lower Manhattan where I cultivated artists and programmed all events for over 30+ years for two performance spaces—including 18 OBIE-award winners—for an annual audience of 30,000. (1993-2025)

I also co-founded and co-curated 13 editions of PROTOTYPE, a city-wide annual opera and music theatre festival. (2012-2025)

During my tenure, HERE and our artists received nineteen OBIEs, two OBIE grants, two MacArthur awards, seven Tony nominations, three Pulitzer Prize nominations, six Drama Desk nominations.

Curated, fund-raised and produced a total of 32 thought-provoking premieres fostering the development of over 300 artists and receiving critical acclaim and recognition within the industry.

Co-created and executed THE AMERICAN LIVING ROOM, an annual festival of new works in theatre, film & video, music and visual art. From 1990-2007, over 500 works (almost all premieres) involving 5,000 artists. Produced in association with Lincoln Center Theater for 5 years.
