Indiana Teaching Licensure Application Process

Requirements for licensure:

- Completion of program(s) at Valparaiso University (official transcript)
- Passing scores on <u>licensure exam(s)</u>
- Current CPR certification
- <u>Suicide Prevention Training</u> certification (1 hour training minimum)

Indiana Department of Education's Licensing Verification and Information System (LVIS 360)

- Create or use an existing LVIS 360 account
 - To use LVIS 360 you must have an <u>Access Indiana account</u>.
- Assistance with LVIS 360 can be found here
- It may take several weeks for your application to be processed and approved
- If seeking multiple licensure areas, include all licensure areas on the same application
- You will upload **transcripts**, **test scores**, **CPR**, **and suicide prevention certificates** to LVIS 360

Before Applying.

- 1. Verify that you have selected Valparaiso University and Indiana Department of Education as recipients of your ETS/Praxis exam scores
 - a. If you have not passed licensure exams, do not apply for licensure until all tests are passed
- 2. Request your transcript and email a digital copy to education.forms@valpo.edu
 - a. <u>Before placing a transcript order, make sure that your transcript has been updated with degree received or record of program completion</u>
- 3. Confirm you have digital copies of your suicide prevention and CPR certificates
- 4. Determine the fees associated with your application

Apply for your Indiana License before completing any other state's application.

- You may need to complete <u>ISBE 80-02</u> and submit it to the Valpo licensure advisor.
