Student Dress Code & Safety Rights

TICKETS & WRISTBANDS

- Tickets must be purchased in advance; there are no refunds for purchased tickets. Certain dances may sell tickets at the door if available (GLOW).
- Every ticketed student must wear a wristband (given at the entrance)
- First Warning—STUDENTS WHO DANCE INAPPROPRIATELY, PUSH, SHOVE, or are ROUGH on the dance floor will be removed, receive a warning and have their WRISTBAND CUT.
- Second Warning—STUDENTS may be removed from the dance and parents will be notified.

BREATHALYZERS & DRUG DETERRENTS

- STUDENTS may be breathalyzed at dance entry, during, or exiting. CAHS reserves the right to search bags if under suspicion of illegal substances.
- Use of a substance canine unit will be enforced at all dances.
- Illegal substance use will be handled per policies outlined in the CAHS Student Handbook and local authorities.

DRESS CODE

- CAHS DRESS CODE MUST BE FOLLOWED; no admittance otherwise
- SHOES MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES—NO EXCEPTIONS

GUEST PASSES

- Student Guests must be pre-approved and ticketed prior to the event.
- Approved & ticketed student guests must check in at the front to be admitted into the dance.
- Guest MUST show current Student ID and be pre-approved for entry—<u>NO</u> EXCEPTIONS.

SAY SOMETHING

- We can all help keep each other safe while enjoying an evening to the fullest! Find an adult chaperone if you need to report inappropriate behavior.
- Take ownership of your actions and watch out for one another!

VERBAL AGREEMENT

By purchasing this ticket, I agree to the DRESS CODE & SAFETY RIGHTS OF STUDENTS for the dance. I understand that it is my responsibility to dress appropriately and to refrain from and report inappropriate behavior at any time during the dance. I also understand that inappropriate behavior will result in wristbands being cut and potentially removed from the dance.

DRESS CODE

CAHS DRESS CODE INCLUDES DANCES & SCHOOL-EVENTS.

Modest Attire Defined:

- Undergarments must be fully covered and not visible
- Torso, chest, buttocks must be fully covered
- No see-through clothing
- Skirts/dresses no shorter than fingertip length while standing
- Articles of clothing must be worn at all times, including shoes!

Safe Attire Defined:

- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- No clothing with illicit or illegal substances, suggestive language/behaviors, or otherwise offensive in nature will be permitted.

SAFETY RIGHTS OF STUDENTS

Students who attend the dance have a right to their personal safety and comfort throughout the dance. All students have a right to enjoy the evening free from sexual harassment, roughhousing, or inappropriate behaviors inflicted by others.

- Students will maintain appropriate dancing while on the dance floor (no shoving, pushing, crowd surfing, rough dancing, freaking, grinding, or sexually explicit movements).
- The following behaviors/actions are strictly prohibited:
 - Inappropriate touching or grabbing of other students while dancing
 - Roughhousing, pushing, and shoving
 - The use of alcohol, nicotine, or any other illegal substance
- Students who do not feel comfortable dancing at any point should stop dancing
