Pequalizer


Pequalizer is a software based GTK+ 10 band graphical equalizer based on <u>alsaequal</u>. It is a system wide equalizer as long as the application playing the sound files is using the alsa sound driver. It uses <u>gtkdialog</u> >=0.8.0 as it's GUI framework so therefore runs as a bash script. Pequalizer is an optional plugin for <u>Pmusic</u>. Download from <u>here</u>. Licenced under <u>GPL v2</u>.

Command Line Options

- -e Run embedded gtkdialog code is pointed to stdout
- -h Show this help message
- -s Setup equalizer no gui
- -v Show pEqualizer version

Graphical Usage

Pequalizer has 10 sliders ranging from 31 Hz to 16 kHz. These sliders are adjusted up and down to suit your preference as with any other equalizer. Simply drag the sliders with the cursor.




By default Pequalizer comes with 4 Preset configurations, Flat, Rock, Jazz and Pop. Make a selection from the pull down list. It is easy to add or delete Presets at any time.

Adding a Preset


To add a Preset, simply choose a name for your Preset, different to the ones already stored and enter it into the box. Adjust the sliders to your preference and then click the "floppy" icon which

saves the change to disk. You will instantly see it in the pull down list.



Deleting a Preset

To delete a Preset just select it from the pull down list, then click the "trash" icon button. It's then deleted permanently.
