Nutshells

Discussion Process Description

Nutshells are designed to give each participant a chance to share what they are up to with the group. The focus is on listening. Each participant will have a designated amount of time to share with the group.

Participant Preparation Information

If you want to participate in this facilitation format, come prepared with an idea to share. For inspiration, take a look at this framing we shared with our storyteller applicants:

- Stone Soup: Great things happening as a result of collaboration or unusual partnerships
- Special Sauce: A story of transformative moments or models
- Apple Cider: Insights or new approaches gained from failure, mistakes, or unexpected changes
- Seasoning: A story of Small Successes it may not be the ultimate goal, but it's a step in the right direction
- Menu Change: Policy campaigns or Grassroots Organizing Examples

5 min	Introductions	 Facilitator explains how this works Each person gets 3-5 minutes to share their work, idea, story Facilitator uses flipchart to record takeaways - speaker's name - in a few keywords/one sentence summarizing what they talked about. If so, we can utilize the other facilitation formats - we may not get through the full process, but could be a start!"
