1963: The first push-button (Touch-Tone) telephones debuted in the United States, eventually replacing most rotary-dial models.

Native American and Alaska Native Heritage Month Focus: It wasn't until 1924 that Native Americans were granted citizenship after Congress enacted the Indian Citizenship Act. While Native Americans were also given the right to vote in 1924, it took another 40 years for all 50 states to allow them voting rights.
