TREASURER'S REPORT:

- WBPA has incurred costs for competition meals. A more detailed update will be provided at the November 15, 2022 meeting.

DIRECTORS' REPORT-MR. KRUEGER:

MARCHING BAND:

- Senior Night is Thursday, 10-13-2022 at the last, regular season home football game.
- State marching band competition at Millard South on 10-22-2022. Students taking the ACT should be done prior to the 1:45 PM call time. Mr. Krueger will send the NSBA State Marching Contest full schedule via email.
- 10-25-2022 Marching Band Concert. Due to a conflict with district volleyball, the concert will be held on the field. The concert will be held in the auditorium if the weather is bad.
- Students will wear their uniforms and perform Duality for the last time at the Marching Band concert. Awards will be given by the Directors and Drum Majors at the concert.
- Mr. Krueger has shared links to youtube videos of the marching competitions on his emails.

PEP BAND-DISTRICT AND STATE GAMES:

- Westside will be hosting district football and volleyball games.
- Students may volunteer to play in pep band and will receive service learning hours.
- 1st pep band opportunity is Volleyball district final on 10-26-2022.
- It is likely Westside will host all District football games (10-28-2022, 11-4-2022 and 11-11-2022).
- Buses will be used to transport the pep band to Lincoln if Westside qualifies for state play-offs (Volleyball: November 2nd 4 & 5 and Football: November 21).**

CONCERT BAND:

- In-person concert band auditions will be held October 26 and 27.
- Audition music has been distributed and timeslots have been assigned to each student.

BAND EXPENSES:
