Types of Questions

Literal (L) = the answer is in the text.

Reorganisation (R) = the answer is in different places in the text

Inference (I) = the answer is suggested and we have to find the clues

Vocabulary (V) = the answer is about the meaning of words

Evaluation (E) = the answer needs us to bring different ideas together

10]. Why was their gift to their friends so good?(I)

11]. Why did Fiti just watch the boys play rugby in his first week at school in NZ? (I)

A]Because he hadn't seen it played like that before, he was nervous that he wouldn't know the rules.

12]. Did Fiti and Malia play rugby in NZ? How do you know (R)

A]Yes they sent photos back to Samoa of them both in their teams.

13]. Why didn't Fiti's NZ friends believe he played with a jandal back in Samoa? (I)
