

The Myrskytuuli Regiment is one of the younger organizations within Raata Zaibatsu. Unlike the other members, The Regiment has no legacy and was formed solely to fill the role of being the Zaibatsu's private military outfit. The High-command of the Regiment is entirely made up of members of House Yaken and will remain this way. Commoners will fill up the rest of the command chain.

'Mryskytuuli' derives from a Raata-dialect that could've been found in the northern hemisphere of Caldari Prime which translates to "Storm wind". Named in honor of the Caldari spirit of battle - '[Storm Wind](#)'. Despite the religious undertone of the name, no one is demanded to be a believer in The Winds, but are expected to show respect for the belief. While the culture of the group is primarily Caldari, The Regiment is open to soldiers of any race. So long as they can prove to be warriors of honor, they will be welcomed as if they were kin.

With the ruling family of the Zaibatsu having a proud history of military feats. The Regiment is shown a certain level of favoritism, who dare say the military need a less funding? They protect the people and represent us out in the battlefields of New Eden! Attacking the Regiment during a council meeting among the Core modules will end badly for whoever decided to put them on the spot. They're practically untouchable to everyone except their close friends in the Ohrion Conglomerate; who share cultural similarities despite working in entirely different fields.

Which is a shame, for there are certain controversies surrounding the Regiment. Such as certain practices that they insist are honorable - for example - kidnapping chemists from the Serpentis Corporation and persuading them to start working the Conglomerate. Or creating squadrons of pirate, hardened criminals and unfortunate individuals who fail to display honor in Zaibatsu society to "rehabilitate" them in honorable combat. Thankfully, those put into these penal squads have a chance to not only become full members of the Regiment; but also be granted citizenship.

Externally the Regiment can operate as a PMC and actively seek out its own contracts to take on. Internally it is not only the armed forces to defend its meager borders. But to keep the peace on the streets and aboard any station controlled by the Zaibatsu. With the exception of the Stelmari exchange - the Regiment is the only module in the Zaibatsu allowed to have an armed force.

The commanding officer in charge is called the "Paalikko", a Raata word for "General". The Paalikko has dictatorship level power to mold the Regiment in his or her image to obtain maximum efficiency. While still answering to the ruling Patriarch of the Zaibatsu, The Paalikko is allowed to expand freely and deploy troops and assets as they please. Though the luxury of expanding freely is extended to every Core module in the Zaibatsu; every sitting chairman of a core module would have to get a green light from the Regiment. This is due to "Security protocols" that demands if any core module seeks expansion in the form of a new facility; they

must have security personnel. With the Regiment being the only legal security supplier in the Zaibatsu. Interested parties will have to convince the Paalikko to release troops to defend their new property. No security - No expansion.
