Staff Sgt. Charles M. Goodrich, 26, son of Mr. and Mrs. Edwin T. Goodrich, 181 Frederick avenue, is serving as an airplane instrument technician in a B-25 Mitchell medium bombardment group overseas, it is announced by Twelfth air force headquarters in Italy. He is an alumnus of Taylor county normal school and Oshkosh State Teachers college. Subsequent to his induction into the army air corps at Fort Sheridan, Ill., in February, 1942, he attended the North American aviation school maintained by the air forces at Inglewood, Calif.
