WBHS PSAT 8/9 & PSAT NMSQT January 26th Details

Distance Learners: Students who have confirmed they are taking the PSAT 8/9 or PSAT/NMSQT (10th and 11th graders) should plan on arriving at 8 am. They should be dropped off at the front of the school. A counselor will check DL students in, and bring them to their testing location. Testing rooms for DL students will be designated for distance learners only-- no in-person learners will be in their rooms. When all distance learners are finished testing, they will be released to the front of the school, where they will be picked up. They are not allowed to stay at WBHS.

In-Person Learners: Students will come to school as normal. There will be QR codes for students to scan and see what room they will be testing in. There will also be rosters printed out at the front of the school, at the "spaghetti junction" intersection (where the 4.200/9.200 hallways meet), and on the 7.100 hall. **ALL 10th GRADERS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE PSAT IF THEY ARE AT SCHOOL.**
