2. Use an i-movie to tell a news report about something that has happened this year.
3. Expand on something you did first semester (like the “what I learned this year” prompt)
4. Create something entirely new, telling a story or poem of your choice.
5. Answer the statement, “THIS IS ME” by expressing yourself with a movie.

**To make an “A” on this project you will need each of the following**

1. An I-movie no shorter than 5 minutes (it can be longer).
2. A project that consists of pictures, sound, and words... all of which you created.
3. Presented to the entire class when we have our movie day.
4. Have a compressed I-movie file that you can transport by May 18<sup>th</sup>
