Motion to Amend the Constitution - The Liberal Advisory & Legislature Substitution Amendments*

Amendment 1 The Liberal Advisory Amendment

Upon passing this amendment, 3 advisor roles would be created, and this amendment will be amended to the Liberal Constitution. The LMC shall start the advisor selection process immediately if this amendment passes.

There shall be a advisor application period decided by the LMC, in which anyone shall have the right to apply. The contents of this application shall be controlled by the LMC.

Using the list of applicants, the 3 advisors shall be nominated by each deputy chair of the party, with veto power by the chair, if the nominated member is vetoed, a unanimous majority by the deputy leadership shall be required to override.

If a deputy chair believes there is no qualified advisors from the list of applicants they may either defer their right to selection to the chair, or choose no one and leave the advisory spot vacant.

Upon an advisor vacancy occurring after an advisor resigns, the the chair shall have the power to select replacements with 2/3 consent of the LMC needed to be confirmed, no application period is needed for this occurrence.

Though the advisors shall have no specific power in terms of decisions of the LMC unless otherwise noted, they shall have moderation oversight of the discord and shall be active in participation of the discussions in management of this party in terms of formation of coalitions among other topics. They shall also oversee management of the party and shall have a duty to report any unethical actions by the LMC.

Amendment 2 Legislative Replacements

Upon passing this amendment the constitution shall be amended to include this amendment, and it shall become active immediately.

Legislative vacancies shall be filled immediately by decision of the LMC each member holding 1 vote in the process including advisors, if there is a tie, the chair shall break the tie. It is recommended that the LMC should have a prepared pool of replacement candidates to pick from. The running of this process in a fair and reasonable manner shall be delegated to the chair. The exception to this rule is with senate elections, due to their importance they shall be held as a special election overseen and conducted by the LMC.
