

September 27, SATURDAY, 6:00 to Dusk Sunset Hike!

Part of our Extinction Rebellion culture is to gather for “regen” events to regenerate our energy and our souls. It’s time we did this!

There is a lovely new Nature Preserve in East Austin, called [Red Bluff Nature Preserve](#). Its view to the West is so amazing, it is known as the Mt. Bonnell of East Austin. *Scroll down for photo!*

We’ll gather from 6 to 6:15, then explore trails, and return to the overlook area at sunset. Bring snacks or a picnic for yourself or to share. After sunset, around 7:45, those who wish may want to go eat together. Rain date: Sat. October 4.

Location: Here is the Google Map location of [Red Bluff Nature Preserve](#), 5808 Harold Court. It is about 2 miles south of E. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd, off of Hwy 183 toll road. This part of Harold Ct. can only be accessed from the southbound Hwy 183 access road.

(We will not be meeting at the “west entrance” of the preserve which shows on some maps.)

There are signs at the main trailhead on the south side of Harold Court. We’ll wait on the street until 6:15 for any stragglers, then follow the trail into the park a little way to find a place to picnic, probably on a blanket or two (we’ll bring some). The overlook is not far from the entrance. Some trails have poison ivy; dress accordingly. Bring water and may whatever else you’ll need as the preserve has no facilities.
