Zoom indicates you can join the meeting without downloading the app on your computer, but you may have limited functionality without the app. Once again, I'm sending a link to the tutorial videos to help you learn more about it before the next meeting.

The meeting is set so you will join the meeting with your sound muted, and without video. We learned from our first online meeting that during the meeting we need to keep everyone muted until you either raise your electronic hand, or type in the chat that you would like to say something. Otherwise, people inadvertently talk over each other making conversation a bit difficult. It's best to keep yourself muted during the meeting in the event the dog barks, the phone rings, etc. It only takes one click of the mute button to resume speech.

You can also join the meeting using your mobile phone if you're not near a computer or tablet, but in that case using the Zoom Cloud Meeting app would probably be best. The Zoom Cloud Meeting app can be found on the App store for IOS, or Playstore for Android devices.
