How was the course designed?

The course was designed by NEB's expert SEL facilitators and aligns to CASEL SEL Framework and RIDE SEL Standards and Competencies.

Who will this course benefit?

This course is tailored for and will benefit:

- District or school level SEL and behavioral leaders and specialists
- School or district level administrators
- Classroom teachers and support teachers stepping into team or school leadership



There are no formal prerequisites for enrolling. However, because this is a specialist-level endorsement course, we strongly recommend that participants have a foundational understanding of the Rhode Island SEL Anchor Standards and Competencies. You can access the full standards document here: RI SEL Standards PDF.

For those looking to build additional background knowledge prior to starting the course, we recommend exploring the following:

- CASEL's free introductory module: Introduction to SEL.
- Bridge RI's free introductory module: Intro Social and Emotional Learning

What is included in the course?

- Seventy (70) professional certification hours including:
 - Ten (10) fully synchronous, virtual trainings led by NEB professional facilitators
 - Practical coursework monitored by NEB facilitators, including a course final project and SEL implementation plan
 - Four (4) 1:1 coaching sessions for each participant (2 virtual, 2 at school/work site)
 - <u>no</u> substitute coverage required

What is discussed in the coaching sessions?

Coaching sessions are designed to support your final project. These sessions are used for collaborative planning, reviewing progress, and identifying strategies tied directly to your goal.. Depending on your needs, these can also include support within your classroom or school setting to help put ideas into action.

How long are the coaching meetings?

Meeting length can vary based on your goal and the kind of support you're looking for, but most are 30 to 45 minutes.

What are the dates?

- Virtual sessions take place approximately every 1-2 weeks over the duration of the course

Is the program endorsed by RIDE?

 Yes! NEB's SEL for Teaching and Leading course is one of only two RIDE approved SEL endorsement courses. Participants who complete all course requirements will be eligible to apply for RIDE SEL endorsement.

What is the cost?

- The total fee is \$2,200 per participant. Group discounts are available (6th and 11th registration are free for groups of 5+ and 10+)
- \$220 Early bird registration discount! Individuals who register and pay 60 days in advance of the course start date receive the discount
