# SATURDAY/ SUNDAY SHOWS \* 1 hour and 45 minutes (approximately)

We try to keep our shows short, sweet, and FUN! Each show will feature different levels and genres of dance. There will be no intermission. Dancers will stay backstage for the entire show. Older MPSD dancers and adult volunteers will help with costume changes so parents can enjoy the show! Performing dancers must be to the theatre early to ensure they are ready for curtain! Please check the SHOW ORDER for your dancer's class(es) to know which show they will be featured in!

\*Dancers using Dressing Rooms may leave items overnight as the spaces will be locked.

Please, no exceptions to the designated students in dressing rooms. It's important to avoid the hurt feelings "exceptions" will cause. We are VERY FORTUNATE to be able to use the spaces we have!!

NOTE: Dancers who need to change in the dressing rooms should have a nude leotard to wear under their costumes. This allows for modesty and eliminates any potentially concerning situations. If you do not have a change, a nude leotard is NOT necessary.

Costumes should be hung on railings in the Choir room or over chairs. NOT placed on the floors or hung over bags or benches.

NO PHOTOS may be taken in any of the Dressing Rooms.

### PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE

**Dancers Arrive: at Noon for each show.** Dancers enter through the auditorium entrance, to the right of the main entrance. To reduce congestion, only 1 adult should accompany younger students to check-in.

On Stage warm up: 12:30-1:30pm Warm up as a group will be given by MPSD instructors during the first 30 minutes. Classes that need additional time will be able to use the stage to rehearse for the remaining 30 minutes.

Auditorium Open: 1:30 No students in auditorium in costumes at any time during performances.

# Recital Begins: 2:00pm Saturday and Sunday

No parents except predesignated volunteers backstage. Feel free to send your younger dancers with something to keep them occupied (ie tablet, book, crayons, coloring books. Please NO MARKERS or PENS, these have damaged costumes in the past!). Please meet dancers in the lobby after the concert for pictures!

# DRESS REHEARSAL

Friday, May 16th: Show A Dress Rehearsal beginning at 4:30pm, Show B Dress Rehearsal beginning at 6:30pm. Please be READY to go at these times, not running into the theater.

ALL IN COSTUME, ALL IN MAKEUP AND HAIR DONE, ALL ON STAGE. Each class will have a chance to come onto stage in show order and walk through their dance with the instructor and then run their dance with music.

WEAR COSTUMES FOR DRESS REHEARSAL for us to set lights, and check costumes, and for dancers to get used to dancing in costumes.

- Professional photographers are taking pictures be in full hair, make up and costume for them!
- Dress rehearsal is the only opportunity for most students to see other dances on the stage. Watch your friends dance!
- Use designated dressing rooms, and go straight to the auditorium, ready to dance.

ALL DANCERS MUST BE PRESENT AT THE BEGINNING OF DRESS REHEARSAL EVEN IF THEY ARE NOT SCHEDULED TO BE ON STAGE UNTIL LATER. We are often able to move ahead of schedule and need all dancers in costume and ready!

- Please arrive 10 minutes before your child's call time listed above.
- Please sign your child in at "dancer drop off". Your child will be with MPSD staff backstage during their rehearsal time. Your child MUST BE SIGNED IN AND OUT. This is for the safety of the dancers and we take it VERY seriously.
- Please do not enter the theatre this is a **CLOSED** rehearsal. Dress rehearsal is closed to ALL parents except designated volunteers.
- Dress rehearsal is mandatory for all dancers participating in the recital. It is imperative that all dancers have the opportunity to be introduced to the stage.
  - Absolutely no jewelry, colored nail polish or stick-on tattoos are permitted to be worn during the rehearsal or the show.
  - We are not responsible for any lost items.
  - Please Note! Tights are considered an undergarment. Additional underwear should not be worn under tights as they will show under the costume.

### **END-OF-YEAR REMINDERS**

May 5th 9th — Last Week of Classes

May 12-16th — Make Up Week (Any classes cancelled by the studio will be made up during this week.)

- Proof read the rough draft of the recital program at the entrance to the studio for any errors in your dance or name. Make corrections on the program please.
  - Make sure your dancer has the appropriate tights and shoes for their costume! (Listed below)

- Check Lost & Found ©
- Check your dancer(s) progress!

### **COSTUMES**

Please make sure your child has the proper color tights and shoes for their costume:

- Creative Movement (A/B), Mini Movers, Ballet Dances- pink tights, pink ballet shoes (girls). Black leggings and black shoes for boys.
- Beg/Int Teen Ballet Black tights, black ballet shoes
- Tap Dancers- tan tights, black shoes
- Jazz Dancers Levels I and II tan tights, beige slip-on jazz shoes
- Jazz Dancers Levels III and IV Convertible tan tights and half soles
- Contemporary / Lyrical- convertible tan tights, half-sole shoes
- Musical Theatre I tan tights and tan jazz shoes
- Hip Hop black or neutral colored tennis shoes with tan tights

### Helpful Hints:

- Be careful not to lose accessories, hair pieces, belts they are impossible to replace. DO NOT PLAY IN OR WEAR COSTUMES PRIOR TO REHEARSALS! Keep them nice for pictures, rehearsals, and shows.
- STEAM wrinkles out (in hot steamy bathroom), or LIGHT COOL IRON WRONG SIDE CAREFULLY with a barrier item such as a thin towel or sheet. Hang to keep neat.
- Hang tutu skirts UPSIDE DOWN from crotch fabric, to keep fluffed out, and up.
- Write out the order of your dances if you have more than one dance to plan your costume changes. Including color of tights and accessories you need.
- Wear a nude leotard under your costume for quick changes!

Young dancers (in Level II and lower) should arrive at Mt Pleasant High School in their first costume with makeup and hair done!

### STAGE MAKE-UP

Parents, help younger children. Stage makeup is similar to street make-up, just a little more pronounced. BLEND! You need to be seen from the balcony, and the amount of light directed on you is extremely bright and will wash out your features. Do not share make-up (especially mascara and liner) without clean or disposable brushes/q-tips. You should invest in your own; sharing make-up also shares bacteria. Older students should practice and learn how to apply their own make-up. Younger students, try to learn, too! We will have people to HELP & CHECK your make-up, but don't rely on them - there isn't time for them to do everyone! Do makeup at home, then bring it with you for touch ups.

Here are some hints and items you should have:

- Blush, in a color which complements your coloring.
- Powder shadows in natural colors (bronze, etc) no blues or greens. Maybelline and others offer great "kits".
- Eyebrow pencil, eyeliner, mascara brown (fair haired) or black (dark haired).
- Moist lipstick clear red shades (bronze for boys)
- Brushes, q-tips and/or throw away sponges for applying make-up, & a box of soft tissues and/or baby wipes.
- Bring plenty of supplies for your hair; bobby pins, coated rubber bands, clips, spray. Scrunchies don't hold!
- No glitter make-up unless directed for the entire class for a specific dance and costume look.

### HAIR

All hair should be up, beautifully pulled away from the face. This is a wonderful opportunity to have dancers' hair

done for this special occasion! Short hair can be done nicely by braiding hair away from the face. Preference is to have all hair UP, off the neck. But short styles need to be cleanly pulled back from the eyes, especially. Help your dancer so their hair is NOT a distraction during their special time on stage!

# EXPECTATIONS FOR Mt Pleasant High School

It is because of your help and responsibility that we can use the MPHS Auditorium.!

- ABSOLUTELY NO CHEWING GUM in the school!
- Always WALK in the halls and in the auditorium. No running.
- No tap dancing on the tile floors! Tap on stage only.
- No wandering around the High School. You should be either in the dressing room or auditorium at all times.
- Leave all costumes and dance bags in dressing rooms.
- Have names inside costumes & shoes! Each year costumes are taken by mistake
- No student should leave the building until his/her belongings are packed and any trash is disposed of.
- NEVER TOUCH ANY STAGE ITEMS curtains, lights, props, equipment, or anything else!
- NO ONE ON STAGE, or touching anything on stage before, during, or after any rehearsals or performances! The High School has charged studios in the past for damages to equipment, which is VERY costly!

### PHOTO & RECORDING INFO

ABSOLUTELY NO RECORDING (video or still) during PERFORMANCES.

It is dangerous for dancers; it is incredibly distracting and rude to other audience members; it is not allowed in ANY theater. Please be considerate of all audience members and our show and do not use cameras or phones during performances!

Note: You cannot post photos of other people's children on Facebook or any other social media site without their permission. Your MPSD registration contract serves as a photo release for your child only for photos and video taken for or by MPSD, not private individuals.

ANY PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHERS (anyone taking photos to sell or distribute in any way) MUST GET PERMISSION FROM MPSD PRIOR TO REHEARSAL WEEK to take any photography.
