# **About Rumpus Room**

Rumpus Room is an artist-led initiative working in collaboration with children and young people on art and social action projects. Rumpus Room Studio is on Langside Lane in Govanhill. The studio is co-run by artists and young studio members, hosting a programme of art and social action projects, developed with and for children & young people in Govanhill and across Scotland.

The studio is run by a small group of part-time staff who work with the RR Young Artist Committee and is supported by an advisory board. The studio also has a wider group of young people who are studio members. Studio members have priority to all our events and workshops, and can also access the studio and resources to host their own projects.

# What to Expect at Rumpus Room

- Small studio space with folding tables to accommodate up to 10-12 people
- In addition, there is a small office that can occasionally be used alongside or instead of the studio. It has a capacity of approximately 10 ppl.
- Outdoor yard space with gazebo and folding tables to accommodate up to 30 people ( please ask for more info about this, as it is a shared space. )
- Access to a small kitchenette with a sink, kettle, microwave and tea urns
- Lots of chairs

- Access to a printer and a desktop computer
- Access to our small library of queer & questioning books, zines/resources made with & for young studio members
- Use of <u>Tender Hands Press</u> riso on request

## **Access**

- The studio is on the ground floor. It is accessed through three doorways.

  The first doorway is 84cm wide, and the other two are currently between 74 cm and 75cm wide.
- There is an accessible ground-floor gender-neutral toilet with a baby-changing station, nappies, and sanitary products. This is shared with Bike for Good and is currently inaccessible from the studio due to a 15cm step.
- We are in the process of installing a ramp to the level with the accessible toilet, once this is in place the toilet will be accessible via ramp through a 79cm wide door.
- Wheelchair users can access this toilet from the yard and through Bike for Good. The studio is lit with bright, white overhead strip lights, with the option of softer lighting provided by lamps.
- The studio is full of things. It is a very visually stimulating environment, with lots of bright colours and things to look at.
- The studio chairs are plastic, with basic back support, no neck or arm support.
- Content warnings will be shared/communicated where necessary.
- The studio is a fairly damp environment and is not scent-free.

# **Studio Yard**

We have a large outdoor yard area that we use to work outside as much as possible. It has a sheltered area which provides cover from the rain with lights and power. We have growing beds, benches and tables, a small shed which can be used to host events in, gazebos and a pizza oven. We share this outdoor space with our landlords, Bike for Good and the group of freelance artists who have a studio space above Rumpus.

Please be aware that we are a DRY SPACE and we do not allow alcohol, drugs or smoking in the studio, or the yard.
