2nd Century Bejeweled Southern Orthodox Crucifix

Starting Bid of 175,000,000 J

Forged of pure silver and inlaid with rubies and bloodstone, this is from an era of ornate and godly craftsmanship. Recently acquired from a private collector, this beautiful cultural artifact of Southern Grundelheim is at the center of a major controversy this year. Several officials of the Ecumenical Synod of Grundelheim, including the outspoken Anglan Bishop Archibald Pope, have claimed that the piece is a stolen master work that ought to be returned to the Church. Southernpiece has actually banned the network of religious fanatics, as well as any proxies, from participating in the auction this year due to a clear history of burning historical artifacts they deem "heretical".

Staff of the Yul Lich

Starting Bid of 150,000,000 J

Ben's Knife #222

Starting Bid of 200,000,000 J
