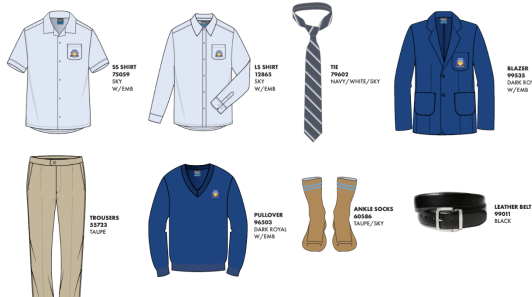




Senior School Uniform Expectations 2026

MASADA COLLEGE | SENIOR BOYS (10-12)

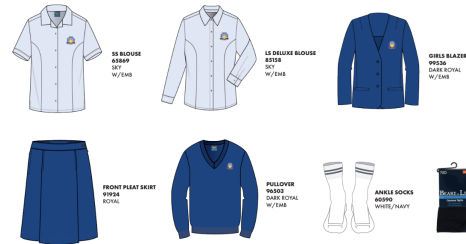


Shirt - tucked in (during winter), trousers, plain black leather shoes (no logos), Tie (winter only), Tan School Socks (never white or black), black belt. Males must be clean shaven - exemptions granted by the College Rabbi to observant Jewish students, during the omer periods.

Blazer to be worn to assemblies and formal events all year. The blazer must be worn to and from school during winter months and kept at school during summer months. Kippah is worn by all boys in the Peleman Centre (Shul, Hall, Teperson) and for Jewish Studies/Hebrew. Optional knitted College jumper & plain navy scarf.

Blouse - button down, Skirt – horizontal hand width above the knee in length, Winter: navy stockings/Summer: white socks, plain black leather shoes (no logos).

Blazer to be worn to assemblies and formal events all year. The blazer must be worn to and from school during winter months and kept at school during summer months. Optional knitted College jumper & plain navy scarf.

Sports Uniform



College tracksuit, College sport sports and College polo shirt for PE lessons. College house t-shirts are for carnivals and House competitions. White socks and sport shoes/sneakers.

Expectations for changing PE Uniform (Years 7-10):

PE in Period 1/2 - change after prayers and back in recess.

PE in Period 3/4 - change at recess and back at lunch.

PE in Period 5/6 - change at lunch and can leave school in PE uniform. *If students are in the workshop, kitchen and science labs they must wear their black leather shoes and full school uniform.*

- Hospitality "hoodie" can only be worn during cooking and appropriate functions. MIT hoodie is not part of the school uniform but can be worn with teacher permission as necessary to the event/ function.
- In Winter students may wear white thermals under their white shirts. Students are permitted to wear the soft shell jacket pictured and/ or your blazer. No other jackets/overcoats are permitted.
- Hair should be clean, neat, of a natural colour, and tied up if touching the shoulder. Hair accessories should match school colours.
- Minimal jewellery can be worn and for religious purposes only. Students may wear a chain necklace displaying a Star of David or a Hamsa. Jewellery should be removed at the request of staff for safety purposes, such as during sport. The loss of any jewellery is not the responsibility of the College. Earrings should be limited to one pair of small plain studs or sleepers. Large diamond (or other stone) studs are not permitted.
- Analogue watches may be worn (no smart watches).
- The wearing of nail polish/fake nails and makeup is not permitted.
