Let's look at some examples of intersectional discrimination.:

Sarah is a Black woman who also identifies as a member of the LGBTQ+ community. In the workplace, she faces the challenge of both racial and LGBTQ+ discrimination, making her vulnerable to bias and stereotyping. However, her intersectional identity also brings a unique perspective and set of skills; like communication and teamwork, empathy and emotional intelligence, and cultural awareness, which can greatly benefit her team and the organization.
