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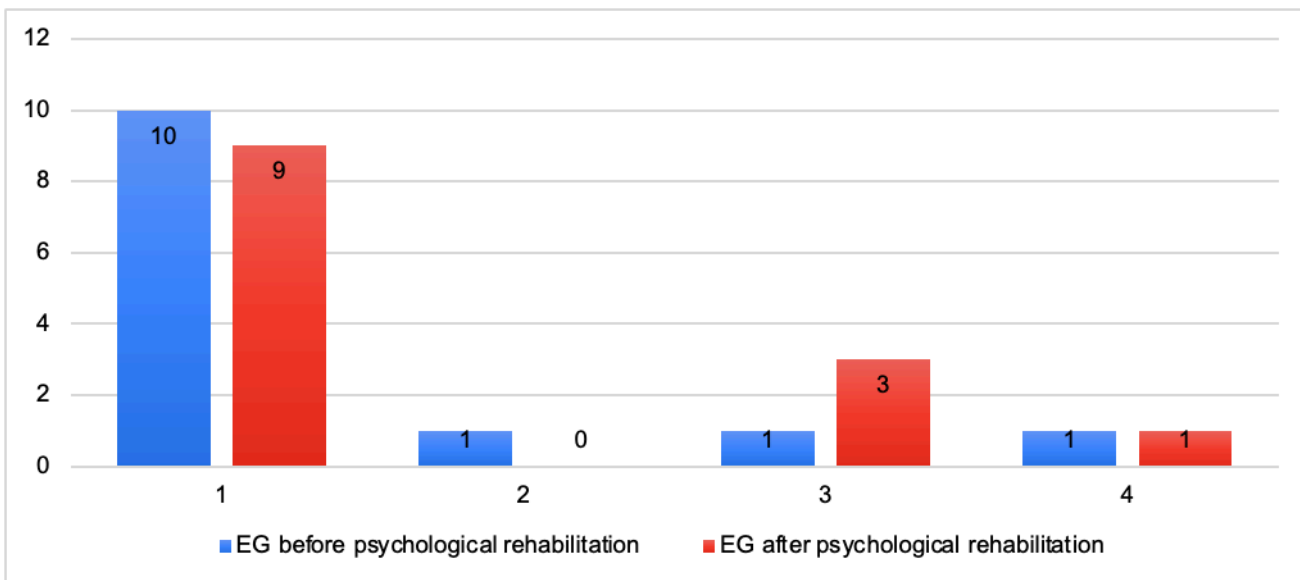


Figure 2: Dynamics of the level of neurotization in the study participants in the experimental group according to the methodology of L.I. Wasserman
