Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP)
<p>Target behaviors (3 max):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. <b>Behavior 1:</b> What does it look like?</li><li>2. <b>Behavior 2:</b> What does it look like?</li><li>3. <b>Behavior 3:</b> What does it look like?</li></ol>
<p><b>Rewards: (What are the rewards and how will the student earn them?)</b></p> <p>Ex: John will use a personalized tracker. He will earn 5 points each time he gets it signed by the teacher. If he earns 20 points, he gets to play soccer with a peer at the end of the day.</p>
<p><b>Environmental Strategies: (What are the things that should be in place all the time?)</b></p> <p>Examples:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. John is learning to ask for a break or do independent work. Praise him when you see this!</li><li>2. Since John elopes, he is seated farthest away from the door</li></ol>
