

Behavior Intervention Plan

Behavior Intervention Plan (BIP)

Target behaviors (3 max):

1. Behavior 1: What does it look like?

2. Behavior 2: What does it look like?

3. Behavior 3: What does it look like?

Rewards: (What are the rewards and how will the student earn them?)

Ex: John will use a personalized tracker. He will earn 5 points each time he gets it signed by the teacher. If he earns 20 points, he gets to play soccer with a peer at the end of the day.

Environmental Strategies: (What are the things that should be in place all the time?

Examples:

- 1. John is learning to ask for a break *or* do independent work. Praise him when you see this!
- 2. Since John elopes, he is seated farthest away from the door



Challenging Behavior & Procedures	
Student Behavior	Teacher Response
1. Calling out/disrupting class	Prompt more appropriate behavior (asking for a break) Privately redirect him if behavior continues
