## QTIP Quit Taking it Personal

PTSD is recognized as diagnosable mental disorder in DSM-5
Developmental Trauma Disorder, and
Complex PTSD/Continuous Traumatic Stress Syndrome are NOT yet recognized in DSM-5
(Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders)

Polyvagal theory: 3 brains - brain, heart, gut body and nervous system connection to coping with stress

Powerful vulnerability matters in church

Story telling -- asking what are the pressure points in your life? Listening.

Community spaces.

Drinks and Deconstruction. Green/Yellow/Red - weekly ground rules.

Testimony focused. Honor the impact of stories of others. Being seen.

Responding to triggers.

Collective care.
