- A lack of transparency in board minutes, ARB proceedings, and public communication.

As one of the taxing entities that participates in the appointment of BCAD's Board of Directors, you have the authority—and the responsibility—to act.

## I urge you to:

- 1. Publicly call for an audit of BCAD finances and appraisal practices.
- 2. Reconsider your entity's support for current BCAD board members.
- 3. Demand the resignation of any board member serving in violation of state law.
- 4. Require public transparency and accountability in all BCAD decisions moving forward.

The time for silence is over. Taxpayers deserve better.
