In 2012 each division was a blowout. Salish Cliffs was a hard course for most...except for the division winners! Division 1 winner: Stephen Lloyd, Division 2 winner: Randy Pettis, Division 3 winner: Vaughn Kercher.

In 2012, we set out to challenge ourselves with a tougher day 2 course by going to Salish Cliffs. Beautiful course, great casino nearby and other than the scores being higher, good experience. The last time we did something similar was back in 2007 at Indian Summer. Both times it seems that the courses did a good job of separating people by their skill levels. In 2007, Mark "Ole" Olsen quieted a lot of griping as he showed that it was possible to score well at a hard course. This year it was Stephen Lloyd's, Randy Pettis' and Vaughn Kercher's turn. Salish turned out to be the second hardest course we have played as displayed by the scores. The hardest was Indian Summer, where we averaged 98.3 strokes, and at Salish Cliffs we averaged 97.7 strokes.

He also had the low gross of 158, being the only player in the tourney who broke 80 at Limerick, followed by being four shots better than anyone else at Salish. Impressive win coach!
