

Spelling Bee Rules

General Rules

- 1. **Eligibility**: Participants must meet the age and grade level requirements set by the competition organizers.
- 2. **Word Selection**: Words will be selected from an official word list provided before the competition or chosen by judges during the event.
- 3. **Order of Competition**: Spellers will compete in a **pre-determined order**, rotating through rounds until a winner is determined.
- 4. **Pronouncer's Role**: The pronouncer will say the word, use it in a sentence (if requested), and repeat it once.

Spelling Process

- 5. Repetition: The speller may ask for the word to be repeated, its definition, or a sentence before spelling.
- 6. **Starting the Spelling**: Once the speller begins, they must **spell the word out** loud clearly.
- 7. Corrections:
 - A speller cannot change letters once spoken.
 - However, they may start over as long as the letters remain the same.

Elimination & Advancement

- 8. **Correct Spelling**: If the word is spelled correctly, the speller advances to the next round.
- 9. **Incorrect Spelling**: If a speller misspells a word, they are eliminated from the competition unless the competition allows a second-chance round.

Championship Round

- 10. Final Two Competitors: When only two spellers remain, they enter the championship round, where standard spelling rules still apply.
- 11. Head-to-Head Format:
- If a speller correctly spells their word, the next speller is given a new word.
- If a speller misspells a word, the other speller must correctly spell a **new word** to win.
- 12. Winning the Competition:
- To be declared the **champion**, a speller must correctly spell **one word after their opponent has misspelled**.
- If the second speller also misspells, both continue competing until one correctly spells a **final word**.
- 13. **Tiebreaker Rounds**: If multiple rounds pass without a winner, judges may select **challenging words** or use a **written spelling test** to determine the champion.

Additional Rules

- 14. **Time Limit**: Spellers have a **time limit** (e.g., 30 seconds) to start spelling after the pronouncer finishes.
- 15. **Judge's Decision**: All judge decisions are final regarding spelling accuracy, rule enforcement, and eliminations.
- 16. **Behavior**: Spellers must conduct themselves respectfully—disruptive behavior may lead to disqualification.
