Following her comprehensive presentation, attendees participated in a fruitful question and answer session, where the speaker addressed various queries, enriching the audience's understanding.

At the end of the seminar, Ms. Rajni Gupta and Dr. Geetan Manchanda gave a token of honour to Professor Charru in the form of a planter. This was followed by a vote of thanks by Ms. Mamtha Godara, who was the coordinator of the session.


