How to enroll in CCP:

- a. _____ Meet the requirements for CCP (Minimum GPA of 3.0)
- b. _____ Meet the requirements for “College Ready” as determined by the college.
- c. _____ Complete the **“Intent to Participate in CCP” form** and turn it in at the UHS Guidance office by **April 1** of every preceding year the student will participate in the CCP program. (Forms must be turned in by March 14, 2025 to participate in CCP during the 2025-2026 school year.)
- d. _____ **Complete the college application for acceptance by:**
 - **YSU:** March 14, 2025 (Summer), April 15, 2025 (Fall), October 31, 2025 (Spring)
 - **KSU:** April 15, 2025 (Summer), June 1, 2025 (Fall), October 15, 2025 (Spring)

Applications will be completed at school on scheduled Application Days.

**Students must be accepted to the college/university before they can choose to enroll for college credit/dual credit courses. Applying, however, does not require students to participate in CCP during the coming school year and students may decide not to participate without consequence.*
- e. _____ Complete course registration with YSU and/or KSU. *If your student earns a failing grade for any CCP course or withdrawals after the deadline, the student and/or parent/guardians will reimburse United Local Schools for the amount of funds paid to the college for the student.*

2. Advanced Placement courses taught by United Local HS teachers: (similar to CCP courses, but to receive credit for AP courses, the students must pass an AP exam for the AP course they are taking). The AP Exam is an independent option for college credit and does not impact the student’s grade in the AP course.

3. CCP at Kent State University taught at Kent-Salem Branch Campus or online by Kent State faculty:

- Students who meet the college ready requirements listed below have the opportunity to take courses through Kent State University. Course offerings change each semester and students are advised at both UHS and Kent Salem. Credits earned through Kent State are applied to UHS graduation requirements.
- **NOTE:** Taking courses at KSU (off-site from UHS) could impact eligibility for Academic Honors, Honors Diploma, etc. based on those specific requirements. Students are responsible for transportation to and from campus, applying to the university, enrolling in classes, and making advising appointments. **Students are not permitted to leave early from a scheduled UHS class.**

Kent State-Salem admission guidelines:

- Minimum 3.0 cumulative high school gpa *or* meet the testing scores below.

Deadline to apply: April 15, 2025 (Summer), June 1, 2025 (Fall), October 15, 2025 (Spring)
(Kent Application day @ UHS-March 19, 2025 @ 8AM)

Youngstown State University admission guidelines:

- **Test Optional:** Students with a minimum unweighted, overall high school GPA of 3.0 and a minimum core* GPA of 2.0 are eligible; no test scores are required.
- **Test Required:** Students with a minimum unweighted, overall high school GPA of 2.0, and a minimum core GPA of 2.0, and meet one of the following college readiness benchmarks:
 - ACT English score of 18
 - ACT MATH score of 22
 - ACT Reading score of 22
 - SAT Evidence-based Reading & Writing score of 480
 - SAT MATH score of 530
 - YSU Accuplacer Reading score of 250
