### **Message from Coach Wendy**

What a fun meet! We had some amazing swims this weekend and we were so happy to see you work so hard in the pool. Highlights definitely included a broken record! But some of the races that made a bigger impression on me were some of the nontime related achievements:

- Several kids who are brand new to the swim team completed their races without being DQ'd for the first time.
- Swimmers remembered to stretch and finish
- Our swimmers remembered to shake hands with their competitor.

While times are important, details like these matter. You are tougher than you think, faster than you know and better than you will ever realize! You are extremely capable. Believing in yourself is 90% of your race. For the most part, your body knows what it needs to do to compete – you just have to allow it to do it! Learning to believe in yourself and to let go in a race is not easy.

### A few tips:

- Stop being afraid of what could go wrong and start being excited about what could go right! "To uncover your true potential, you must first find your own limits and then have the courage to blow past them." (Picabo Street)
- Be determined. Even if you don't make your goal, don't give up on your goal. Reset it and do it again. "A goal should scare you a little and excite you a lot." (Joe Vitale)
- Focus on what's ahead of you, not behind you. Focus on our upcoming three meets. That's what matters. What are you going to do against Park Terrace or at the Sierra Sharks pool? What about at Champs? Success is different for everyone. Keep a proper perspective and do your personal best.

Please remember that we are here to help! Now is the time to make changes if needed – not the week before Champs.
