Library Lesson Plan

Lesson Name: Become a Library Catalog Ninja!

Target Audience: High School (may be adapted for grades 3-8)

Collaboration: Option to work in pairs or teams to finish 'first' (Students). Can customize for specific subjects and projects with teachers.

Overview:

The library catalog is underutilized by students without proper instruction. Students often don't see the value in learning how to properly use the catalog so they spend more time than needed looking for library resources, often without success or always depend on the librarian to find resources for them.

Objective:

Students will learn how to efficiently and successfully maneuver the library catalog to successfully locate desired resources.

Essential Question:

How do I efficiently & independently locate relevant materials in the library?
