- Funding requests
 - Frontier \$163 to print student-authored books for Moroccan students 150

 - Stern \$412.50 for graduation cords for Trailblazers (~50 kids) and Positive Peer Influence (~30 kids) - did it last year, that was the first year - not approved, look at how other classes fund their cords
 - Leege \$216 field trip for African-American Humanities class (8 students, 4 adults) ask individuals to pay, PTSO will fund scholarships if needed
