Outstanding Scientist Award

Since 1962, the Academy has intermittently presented awards to distinguished New Mexicans for their outstanding contributions to science or science education. The award is given in all science disciplines for works supporting the purposes of the Academy. These purposes include the following: to promote science and science education within the State of New Mexico; improve communication among scientists, science educators, and the New Mexico public and its governmental representatives; recognize scientists, science educators, and science students; encourage scientific research; and increase public awareness of the role of science in human progress and human welfare.

Awardees in the past have included Dr. W. Randolph Lovelace II, Chief of the U.S. Army Air Corps Aero-Medical Laboratory and founder of Lovelace Clinic in Albuquerque, Clyde Tombaugh, NMSU, the discoverer of Pluto, Norris Bradbury, Los Alamos, for whom the Bradbury Museum is named, and George Fischbeck, a science educator and TV weather man, NMAS gave the Outstanding Science Award, in 2020, to Dr. Angela Wandinger-Ness, University of New Mexico.
