

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures regarding collecting, using, and disclosing your information when you use our website (the "Service"). It also informs you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

Interpretation

The words capitalized in this Privacy Policy have specific meanings defined under the following conditions. The definitions provided here apply regardless of whether the terms are singular or plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

Account refers to a unique account created for you to access our Service or specific parts of it.

Company (referred to as "the Company," "we," "us," or "our") refers to 828 Bail Bonds LLC, located at 530 Merrimon Ave, Suite C, Asheville, NC 28804.

Cookies are small files placed on your computer, mobile device, or any other device by a website containing details of your browsing history and other relevant information.

The country refers to North Carolina, United States.

Device means any device, such as a computer, cellphone, or digital tablet, capable of accessing the Service.

Personal Data refers to any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual.

Service refers to our Website.

Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes data on behalf of the Company. This may include third-party companies or individuals employed by the Company to facilitate the Service, provide the Service on our behalf, perform services related to the Service, or assist the Company in analyzing how the Service is used.

Usage Data refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Service or from the Service infrastructure itself (e.g., page visit duration).

The website refers to 828 Bail Bonds, accessible from http://www.828bailbonds.com.

You mean an individual accessing or using the Service or a company or other legal entity on whose behalf that individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Personal Data

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you. This information may include, but is not limited to:

- Email address
- First name and last name
- Phone number
- Address, state, province, ZIP/postal code, city

Usage Data

We collect Usage Data automatically when you use the Service.

Usage Data may include information such as your Device's Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser type, browser version, pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service or access it through a mobile device.
