# 2013 Dove Creek Omnium Race Bible

## July 13-14, 2013

The 2013 Dove Creek Omnium is comprised of 3 events: a Saturday morning Royston Criterium, the Burns Road Time Trial on Saturday afternoon, and the Dove Creek road race Sunday morning. Categories on offer are A/B/C.

Cost: Adults: \$20 per event or \$50 for all three

Juniors: \$10 per event or \$25 for all three

Masters: \$20 per event or \$50 for all three


You can race one, some, or all the events. It does not matter if it is the last event of the omnium, all racers are welcome!

Saturday Morning Royston Criterium

Registration is at the entry of the course on Cameron Road, and opens at 930am with the first racers off at 1030 am. All races are "time +2 laps."

Category	Start Time	Race Time
Category C	10:30am	25 min +2 laps
Category B	11:00am	35 min +2 laps
Category A	11:45am	45 min + 2 laps

Note: No practise laps on course when races are underway. No parking on the course, park elsewhere.




#### Saturday Afternoon Time Trial

Registration for the time trial is at the Dove Creek Hall on Burns Road. Registration opens at 3:15 pm with the first rider off at 4:01pm. There are bathrooms in the Dove Creek Hall, please respect the surrounding area residents! Time trial bikes are allowed. Riders will start with Masters category, C, B, A

in the reverse order to the criterium finish (Masters will be by age). The As and Bs will go twice around for a total of 16.2kms. The Cs will do it once around for a total of 8 kms. There will be 1 minute between riders.

No warming up on Burns Road to the west of the Dove Creek Hall after 3:55 pm. No riding on Burns Road to the west of the Dove Creek Hall upon completion of your race. Please find another place to cool down.

Results will be posted online on Saturday evening, approaching the start area after your TT will result in disqualification of rider.



Riders start and finish near the Dove Creek Hall. Please see map below!

### Sunday Morning Road Race

Registration is at the Dove Creek Hall on Burns Road, registration opens at 9:00 am, with all racers required to attend the pre-race briefing at 9:55am. Races will commence at 10:00 am. There are bathrooms at the Dove Creek Hall, please respect the surrounding residents' property! The course starts at the Burns Rd-Condensory Rd intersection, with the finish line 3 km up Piercy Rd (from the Piercy Rd-Condensory Rd 4-way stop). The yellow line rule is always in effect, before, during, and after the race. Any racer found to have crossed the yellow line in the sprint will be disqualified.



Race Lengths: A: 85.34km (5 laps), B: 68.84km (4 laps), C: 52.34km (3 laps)

Notes!

- Cash prizes are for the overall category A/B/C, not per stage.
- Women Racers If there are sufficient women racers within a category, cash prizes will be awarded to female riders dependent upon the number in the category. 3-4 women in a category first place prize will be awarded. 5-7 women in the category prizes for top 2 women. 8 or more women in the category prizes will be awarded for the top 3 women. Prizes will be the same as for the overall in the category. If there are sufficient women in the group for prizes then separate male and female prizes will be awarded although the women racers will not be put in a poorer position by having separate prizes.
- Draw prizes for all riders/volunteers
- The yellow line rule is in effect at all times!
- No littering, offenders will be disqualified!
- Bathrooms are provided at the time trial and road race, NOT the criterium, no public urination!
- All courses are on open roads!
- Results for Saturday will be posted Saturday evening after the both races, results will be posted as soon as possible after the road race, please do not pester the race officials!
- There are no feed zones for the three events
- Points are awarded for all three events, with the winner having accumulated the most points in their category!
- If you DNF from any stage you will receive no points, but can start other stages (and receive points).
- If the race director pulls you from the race (or unable to finish the stage due to circumstances beyond the normal), you will receive the lowest amount of points possible, and can start other stages.
- Dropped riders in the criterium are to ride on the right hand side of the road, must not impede passing groups, and cannot rejoin the group when lapped. The race director may remove lapped riders in the criterium.

#### <u>Local</u>

Local level riders can choose whichever category based on their race experienc and/fitness. If a club member is over the age of 30, they can choose whether to race masters or not! CVCC club members in the running for the Comox Cup series are competing against each other for all three events, points for the series will only be awarded for the CVCC members!

#### Masters

Master level riders will be split with all master level riders over age 55 racing in the B category, and all master level riders under the age of 55 riding in the A category. All three events are masters sanctioned!

#### Directions:

From the New Island Highway for the TT and RR: Take 1<sup>st</sup> right onto Piercy Road (5.1km), take left on Condensory (1.6km), take a left onto Burns Road (160m), take a right into the Dove Creek Hall parking lot.

From the New Island Highway for the Crierium: Take a right onto the Comox Valley Parkway, take a right onto the Island Hwy S, right onto Royston Road, left onto Cameron Road.
