

The Title of Article (Cambria 16 pt, bold)

The title reflects the main topic of the article. The title must be coherent and straightforward and contain the main variables of the research. The title consists of a maximum of 12 words and is written using title case and bold, with a size of 16 pt. Avoid using titles with parenthesis openings ().

Author Name (cambria 12 pt)

The author's identity in the form of the name, email address, and the institution.

Abstract (Cambria 12 pt, bold)

The abstract must be written in English and Indonesian. The abstract is a summary of the article. The abstract is written in one paragraph with single space and the maximum length is 250 words. The abstract must be straightforward and contains four aspects of logical reasoning such as the importance of the research, approaches or methods that are used, the result of the research and conclusion. (IMRAD: introduction, methods, results, analysis, and discussions. (Cambria 9 pt)

Keywords: contains 3-5 keywords (cambria 10)

Introduction (cambria 11 pt, bold)

The introduction includes background, research objectives, literature review, theoretical foundation, and research methods. (cambria 11 pt)

Body of the article (Result, Analysis/discussion) (cambria 11 pt, bold)

This section contains an explanation of the results or research findings. Research findings are analyzed by reference to theoretical foundations. In this section, sub-sections of the discussion can be displayed with their own bold titles. (Cambria 11 pt)

Conclusion and Recommendation (Cambria 11 pt bold)

This section contains answers to the problems found in the introduction. This answer is the final conclusion of what has been discussed and analyzed in the previous section. The sentence in this section is statement of conclusion, not summary. May also be included recommendations for the next author. (Cambria 11 pt)

Bibliography (Cambria 11 pt bold)

The reference source is the most recent literature, preferably scientific journal articles. The format for writing a bibliography follow the APA (American Psychological Association) format instructions. It is recommended to use the Mendeley reference management application. (Cambria 11pt)
