**Program Dates: June 6 - July 1**

**Course Fees:** Please be sure to check the course description booklets for course fees. Fees are payable at the time of registration.

**Program Tuition:** All students who live outside the boundaries of the Clintonville School District may participate in the district's summer school program on a tuition basis. The tuition for out of district students will be **\$3.00 per instructional hour** plus course fees.

**Student Information Form:** All students must have a student information form on file indicating any health conditions, summer emergency contact information, and whether or not they will be riding the bus.

**Student Drop off: Breakfast starts at 7:50 am, classes start at 8:30 am. Please do not drop your child off before that time.**

**Summer School Locations & Times:** Rexford-Longfellow Elementary School, unless otherwise indicated. Many of the classes will be offered in three sessions with each session lasting approximately one hour. There are some courses that will run the entire three hours. (8:30 - 11:40) Please check the times in the course description booklet.

- High School credit courses will run 8:00-11:40 @ **Rexford-Longfellow** (Please register with Mr. Huettner, High School Guidance)
- Courses will run in three periods (8:30-9:30) (9:35-10:35) (10:40-11:40) 4K & 5K courses (8:30-11:40) @ **Rexford-Longfellow**

**FREE MEALS:** Breakfast will be served daily from 7:50-8:20 and lunch from 11:30-12:00 in the Rexford-Longfellow Elementary Cafeteria. **All students will receive FREE meals.**  
**Why is it free??** Due to the participation rate in the Clintonville Schools, the district qualified for this special summer program that provides meals to all children 18 and under. Any questions, please call Karleen @ 823-7215 ext.2265.

**Summer School Staff:** All programs will be taught by certified teachers. Efforts will be made to keep pupil-teacher ratios at a level which foster opportunities for maximum pupil-teacher instructional interactions.

**Course Offerings:** Course schedules are available for parents to print during the online scheduling process. Some courses may need to be eliminated if there is an insufficient number of students. Parents will be notified in late April of any courses that have been canceled.

**Attendance:** It is important that students try to attend the scheduled days as much as possible, but summer school attendance is not mandatory. Students may be excused for family vacations, summer camps or clinics, church camps or clinics, illness, family emergencies, etc. Courses for credit have attendance requirements. We encourage you to notify the Summer School office at 715-832-7215 ext.3200 to let us know when your student will not be attending.

**Grading:** There are no grades given in elementary courses. Grades are only given for credit courses when offered for middle and high school students..

**Dress:** Students may dress casually, but they should always dress appropriately. Students will need sturdy shoes that can be worn out-of-doors or in classrooms.

**Conduct:** Any discipline problems could result in a denial of summer school attendance. Regular school conduct rules will be followed during the summer program. Students are expected to go home when their instructional session ends.
