Poster Presentation Guidelines

1. Abstract Submission

- Submit your abstract here by 26 July 2026:

- Abstract should be 250-300 words and includes headings

2. Poster Format

- Poster Size: A1 (59.4 cm wide x 84.1 cm high)
- Layout: Portrait
- Language: English
- Font: Arial, minimum 20 pt (larger fonts are recommended for headings)
- Ensure the poster is readable from 1–2 meters away.

3. Poster Content

- **Original Research:**
 - Introduction
 - Objectives/Aim
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Discussion
 - Conclusion
 - Acknowledgements (funding, collaborators, ethics approvals if applicable)
 - References (Only 3–5 key references)
- **Clinical Case Report:**
 - Introduction
 - Case Presentation
 - Intervention/Outcome

- Discussion
- Conclusion / Learning Points
- Patient consent/ethics (if applicable)
- References (Only 3–5 key references)

4. Poster Design

- Keep the poster clear, concise, and visually appealing. Avoid excessive text.
- Organise the content with a logical flow from top left to bottom right (3–5 columns recommended).
- Clearly separate sections using headings, spacing, or lines.
- Ensure all figures, tables, and graphs are clearly labelled with informative captions. Visual elements should occupy approximately 50% of the poster.
- Use simple language and minimise abbreviations. If abbreviations are used, define them on first use.
- Highlight the main findings and conclusions.
- Use adequate white space to improve readability and avoid clutter.
- Use consistent fonts, colours, and formatting throughout the poster.

5. Poster Display

- Display your poster on the assigned poster board according to your poster number.
- Ensure the poster number is clearly displayed as instructed by the organizer.
- Presenters must bring their own Velcro or other mounting materials, as these will not be provided.
- Posters must be displayed from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm (MYT).
- Please remove your poster by 5:30 pm. Posters remaining after this time will be removed by the secretariat.

6. During the Poster Session

- At least one author must be present during the designated poster viewing session to discuss the work and answer questions.
- Posters should present educational and scientifically balanced information.
- Poster handouts are optional but encouraged.
