

Materials:

- Main Color (MC): 7 balls of We Are Knitters 'The Pima Cotton' in the color Olive (100g/ball, 700g total)
- Accent Color (AC): 1 ball of We Are Knitters 'The Pima Cotton' in the color Natural (100g/ball, 100g total)
- US Size 8 (5mm) circular knitting needles

Gauge:

- In 2 inches: 12 rows and 9 sts

Sizing:

- XS/S (M/L; XL/2XL; 3XL/4XL)
- Bust circumference: 29-33 inches (37-41 in; 45-49 in; 53-57 in)
- Bust Width: 18 inches (20.25 in; 24 in; 28 in)
- Neck Width: 8 inches (8 in; 8 in; 10 in; 10 in)
- Arm Length: 20 inches (20 in; 22 in; 24 in)

Front/Back: (Knit 2 of these pieces, flat)

- Bottom ribbing:
 - Cast on 90 (100; 120; 140) sts in AC
 - Knit in k1p1 twisted rib for 4 rows
 - Switch to MC, k1p1 twisted rib for 2 rows
 - Switch to AC, k1p1 twisted rib for 3 rows
 - Switch to MC, k1p1 twisted rib for 1 row
- Body:
 - Knit in stockinette stitch for 20 rows
 - Knit in moss stitch for 20 rows
 - Knit in stockinette stitch for 50 (60; 80; 110) rows
 - Total of 90 (100; 120; 150) rows, without ribbing
- Neck Shaping:
 - Row 91 (101; 121; 151) : Knit 43 (48; 58; 68) sts, cast 4 off, knit 43 (48; 58; 68)
 - Piece is now divided into two sides
 - **Side one:**
 - Row 92 (102; 122; 152): Purl to last stitch, slip one
 - Row 93 (103; 123; 153): Slip two stitches purlwise; pull the first stitch over the second (first cast off stitch), knit the next stitch and pull second slipped stitch over this; knit to the end of the row
 - In total, 2 sts cast off
 - Row 94 (104; 124; 154): Purl to last stitch, slip one

- Row 95 (105; 125; 155): Slip two stitches purlwise; pull the first stitch over the second (first cast off stitch), knit the next stitch and pull second slipped stitch over this; knit to end of the row
 - In total, 2 sts cast off
- Row 96 (106; 126; 156): Purl to last stitch, slip one
- Row 97 (107; 127; 157): Slip two stitches purlwise; pull the first stitch over the second (first cast off stitch), knit the next stitch and pull second slipped stitch over this; knit to end of the row
 - In total, 2 sts cast off
- *For XL/2XL and 3XL/4XL*
 - Row 128/158: Purl to last stitch, slip one
 - Row 129/159: Cast off 2 sts, knit to end
 - Row 130/160: Purl to last stitch, slip one
 - Row 131/161: Cast off 2 sts, knit to end
- Continue knitting in stockinette stitch until row 108 (118; 138; 168)
- Row 109 (119; 139; 169): Cast off
- **Side two:**
- Row 92 (102; 122; 152): Attach yarn; cast 2 stitches off, purl to end
- Row 93 (103; 123; 153): Knit to last stitch, slip one
- Row 94 (104; 124; 154): Slip 2 stitches purlwise; pull the first stitch over the second (first cast off stitch); purl the next stitch and pull second slipped stitch over this (second cast off stitch); purl to end of row
 - In total, 2 sts cast off
- Row 95 (105; 125; 155): Knit to last stitch, slip one
- Row 96 (106; 126; 156): Slip 2 stitches purlwise; pull the first stitch over the second (first cast off stitch); purl the next stitch and pull second slipped stitch over this (second cast off stitch); purl to end of row
 - In total, 2 sts cast off
- *For XL/2XL and 3XL/4XL*
 - Row 127/157: Knit to last stitch, slip one
 - Row 128/158: Cast off 2 sts, purl to end
 - Row 129/159: Knit to last stitch, slip one
 - Row 130/160: Cast off 2 sts, purl to end
- Continue in stockinette stitch until row 108 (118; 138; 168)
- Row 109 (119; 139; 169): Cast off

Sleeves: (Knit 2 of these pieces, flat)

- Cast on 75 (87; 99; 120) stitches in MC
- Knit in stockinette stitch for 50 (60; 80; 100) rows
- Knit in moss stitch for 20 rows

- Knit in stockinette stitch for 19 rows
- Row 90 (100; 120; 140): *p1, p2tog* repeat until end of row
- Row 91 (101; 121; 141): Knit
- Row 92-94 (102-104; 122-124; 142-144): Switch to AC, knit in k1p1 twisted rib
- Row 95-96 (105-106; 125-126; 145-146): Switch to MC, k1p1 twisted rib
- Row 97-100 (107-110; 127-130; 147-150): Switch to AC, k1p1 twisted rib
- Row 101 (111; 131; 151): Cast off

Neckline:

- Lay front/back pieces right sides out, sew together along the bound-off edges on top using mattress stitch
- Once the shoulders are sewn together, pick up stitches along the neckline with AC
- Knit 3 rows in k1p1 twisted rib
- Switch to MC, knit 3 rows in k1p1 twisted rib
- Switch to AC, knit 2 rows in k1p1 twisted rib
- Cast off using stretchy cast off method

Finishing:

- Line up the sleeves right side out (folded lengthwise) and sew onto body using mattress stitch
- Sew up length of arms using mattress stitch, sew up sides of body using mattress stitch
- Turn the sweater inside-out and weave in ends!
