

Rules and Regulations

1. Registration:

- a. All guests are required to register and pay the guest fee to secure a guest pass before entering the camp site. Please review our "Registration" and "Tickets" pages on registration and ticketing processes.
- b. Camping and Parking:
Every group will be assigned to its own tent area. Please be respectful to other groups and keep your tents within the assigned area. Parking is allowed in designated areas only - on the curb side next to the camp area. Parking is not allowed in the tent area. If you are having difficulties with parking, please contact one of the org. committee members.

2. Pets:

- a. Pets are welcome provided they are under strict control of the owner and pet owners adhere to the following regulations:
- b. Pets must be accompanied by an adult and on a leash of no longer than 12 feet at all times OR be physically controlled by their owner (small dog in your lap). Owners of unleashed or unattended dogs will be given one (1) warning, following a mandatory eviction without monetary refund.

PLEASE NOTE: appropriate authorities (including police and/or animal control) will be contacted for eviction and dog removal purposes.

- c. Pets are not allowed in or around the pool area, and on or near the children's playground. Please note that these areas are not leased by KSP-Midwest for the purposes of the Slet. All guests must follow the Sky High Camping rules.
- d. All pet owners must provide their pet's medical information (Name, Breed, Veterinarian/Clinic, date of last vaccination) at registration time. No dog without proper information would be allowed on the campsite at any time.
- e. Owners of biting pets will be evicted immediately without monetary refund.
- f. No Pit Bulls, Rottweiler or ill-tempered, aggressive dogs allowed on the campsite at any time.
- g. Pet waste must be removed, properly bagged and disposed off in the dumpster.
- h. The pet owner is fully and solely responsible for any damages, bites, or other injuries caused by his or her dog. KSP-Midwest will assist in any conflict resolution resulting from the Slet; however, KSP-Midwest bears no responsibility for any injuries or damages caused by a dog during the Slet.

3. Conduct:

While at the campsite, respectful and orderly conduct shall be maintained at all times. Loud foul language, obscenity, disorderly conduct towards other campers, their campsites, belongings, comfort and privacy will not be tolerated. Any and all guests engaging in such activities will be given one (1) warning, following a mandatory eviction without monetary refund. Authorities will be contacted as needed.

4. No soliciting:

Guests are not allowed to announce or advertise any products or services without the permission of org. committee. Emergency announcements are allowed only (child lost, health emergency - looking for medical help, etc.).

5. Electronic music and karaoke:

No electronically enhanced music is allowed at the Slet at any time, including any type of stereo music, boomboxes, karaoke and so on. This event is focused on live music. Any and all guests playing loud electronic music and interfering with the spirit of the Slet will be given one (1) warning, following a mandatory eviction.

6. Campfires:

Campfires are allowed in the designated areas (look for the fire pit on your site) and must be kept at a reasonable size and extinguished before retiring at night or leaving your campsite. No chopping, sawing or collecting trees for firewood. Limited firewood supply will be provided for Friday and Saturday night campfires. Additional firewood can be purchased at the campground office.

7. Camp Site Maintenance:

Sites shall be kept in a well maintained condition. Upon departure from the campground, sites must be free from trash, food leftovers or any other debris. Group Captains are responsible for enforcing this rule and leaving their

assigned areas in clean condition.

8. Fireworks & Firearms:

No fireworks or firearms of any kind are allowed on campground property.

9. Golf Carts:

Driving golf carts is permitted to adults only. Children 18 years old and younger are not allowed to drive and should be accompanied by an adult. This rule will be enforced by both KSP-Midwest and Sky High employees.

10. Breach of Policy:

Org Committee reserves the rights in its sole discretion to make changes to the above rule at any time deemed necessary. By the discretion of the Org Committee, its members and representatives, breach of any of the above rules and regulations shall be cause for immediate eviction from the premises, without monetary refund. Local police and other authorities, as needed, will be contacted to enforce the rules.

KSP-Midwest Waiver of Liability

Any individual entering the KSP-Midwest Slet ("Slet") event, located at the Sky High Camping Resort, voluntarily agrees to obey by the rules provided on the KSP-Midwest and Sky High Camping websites and voluntarily assumes any and all risks associated with participation in a public outdoor event, including, but not limited to risks associated with food, beverage, and plant poisoning; animal, pets and insect bites; physical discomfort, personal injuries, and death; loss, damage or destruction of property, and the like.

Further, any individual entering the Slet voluntarily agrees to release and hold KSP-Midwest and its agents free from any and all liability, including financial liability, resulting from any damage to property and or person, including death, that may occur at the Slet, or as a result of the Slet. As such, any individual entering the Slet forfeits all right to bring a lawsuit against KSP-Midwest and its agents for any reason associated with the Slet.

KSP-Midwest acting through any of its officers and agents shall, in its sole discretion and without any reason, be entitled to remove any ticket holder or participant in the Slet at any time from the grounds of the Slet and exclude such person(s) from any further participation in this event.

KSP-Midwest reserves the right to refuse service to anyone or any group in its sole discretion and without any reason.
