

## Requesting a PI Waiver for a Columbia Global-Funded Project

## **Instructions:**

To determine whether you are eligible to serve as a Principal Investigator (PI), please refer to Columbia University's guidelines <a href="here">here</a>.

For individuals who are ineligible to serve as a PI, an exception may be requested by submitting the following to Wafaa El-Sadr, EVP for Columbia Global at <a href="mailto:evpcolumbiaglobal@columbia.ed">evpcolumbiaglobal@columbia.ed</a>:

- 1. A letter signed by the appropriate Chair **and** Dean (or equivalent officers), using the template provided on page 2 (below)
- 2. The investigator's CV
- 3. An abstract of the project to be covered by the exception
- 4. A certificate showing that the investigator has completed the Rascal online course <u>TC5900:</u> <u>Introductory Training for Principal Investigators</u>. Passing a multiple-choice quiz with a minimum score of 85% is required to receive credit. Refresher training is not required.
